Dear Westview,

The season of Advent is upon us! The word "Advent" comes from the Latin *adventus* which means "arrival" or "coming." As we celebrate the season we would do well to reflect, "What is arriving in my life?" What new thing is coming? This doesn't always mean it is something wonderful, it could be what the poet Rumi describes as "A crowd of sorrows" knocking on your door.

The spiritual reality of something new coming/something old leaving is the death/resurrection principle at the heart of the gospel we can never escape. When something new arrives, something old has passed away. Jesus said it beautifully, "You don't put new wine in old wineskins."

If we ask ourselves "What is ending?" we stir up our Inner Protectors—the strategies we use to protect ourselves from our old wounds, our traumas, our unlived lives. When this happens it is important to focus on our True Selves, the wholeness we have as created in the image of God. To help us in our important work, we have a number of invitations for you this Advent season.

- 1. Use our Advent Devotional booklet by Henri Nouwen with the Advent wreaths donated by a family in the church. Make this an intentional, daily, spiritual practice.
- 2. On Sunday, December 11th at 2pm we will be having a "Blue Christmas" prayer and healing service at the church. The service intentionally reaches those who are suffering change and loss during this time of year.
- 3. Treat yourself to Longmont Symphony performing parts of The Messiah on December 17th and 18th @ 4pm at Westview.
- 4. Christmas Eve: this year we will be holding Christmas Eve Service at 2pm, Saturday, December 24th. The worship service on Sunday, December 25th is by video through the Presbytery of Plains and Peaks.
- 5. New Year's Communion and Renewal Service in The Gathering Place. Begin 2023 with a unique service on New Year's Day as we ring in the new year with communion.

My prayer is that something during this Advent season arrives in an unexpected way and grabs your attention. I hope this something awakens your longing, deepens your love, and liberates you from whatever doldrums life may have marooned you in.

Session Notes

At their regular meeting on November 17, 2022, Session took the following actions:

- Approved: A stretch budget of just over \$322,000 for 2023, which includes a 5% pay increase for most staff and some cuts to other areas, including the mission outreach budget. Budget conversations with the congregation will begin after the first of the year, leading up to the Annual Congregational Meeting on Sunday, January 29, 2023.
- Voted: To call a Congregational Meeting to receive the report of the Nominating Committee and to elect new officers on Sunday, December 4, 2022. A second Congregational meeting will be Sunday, December 11, 2022 for installation of new officers.

Boulder Dinner Theatre is closing its doors in August, 2023.


The last show will be Sound of Music, and tickets are on sale NOW. Church members used to get group tickets


