Dear Westview,

Thank you for your thoughts and prayers during my unexpected dance with COVID-19 the last couple of weeks. I have learned you can be careful, but if you are around other people who are not as careful you can still contract the virus. I am feeling fine and glad to be out of quarantine. I am however, still wrestling a bit with the fact that I have joined the ranks of those who hosted the virus.

During these days it is Important to keep our "heart space" open. The parables of Jesus all talk about this theme in one way or another. The kingdom of God is a powerful presence—if we keep our hearts open and awake to it. What looks like his favorite parable—the Parable of the Sower—talks about the kinds of soil in which the Word of God is planted. The point is for our hearts to be fertile ground--receptive and uncluttered and free from worry. This is the hardy soil in which the Word can flourish.

I am reminding you (and myself!) as we enter into the season of Lent this month, to keep our hearts open. The invitation is to pay attention to the work of the Spirit of the risen Christ through our emotions, through our relationships, through serving the poor, through even our dreams. Here are some prompts to reflect upon: What has my heart's attention these days? Is it friends? My physical health? Grief? How might I be distracted from what God might be communicating to me through these concerns?

Session update: The Session is working on several initiatives for 2021. At the time of this writing, we are still discussing and discerning, but a few of the initiatives include discernment about the coronavirus vaccine and returning to in-person worship, relaunching spiritual formation for all ages, outreach into our community, and engaging the congregation in creating a master plan for our facilities.

Please keep our family of faith in your prayers. The days are lengthening a bit, the season of Lent begins this month, and Easter lies just around the corner!



Once again, we began the year with renewed hope — renewed hope that situations will improve for our shoppers and renewed faith that The ROUND PANTRY will serve those whose situation means not having enough food for their families and themselves.

Our faith is based on our trust in God's provision as shown in the heartfelt support that comes to us from so many directions in so many ways.

We were blessed with significant monetary donations at the end of 2020. These donations will enable us to fill out categories (such as peanut butter and canned meat) so that all shoppers receive important nutrition.

We have continued to welcome new volunteers as they join current volunteers in packaging and distributing food. And, our volunteers welcomed new equipment that provided increased safety (cones and lane markers, walled canopies, lights and heaters.) This equipment was funded by a grant from Longmont Community Foundation.
