This month the Spiritual Journeys ministry area is bringing something new to congregational life at Westview with a half-day retreat at Highlands Camp, Saturday June 26th from 1pm – 5pm.

We will gather in the lobby of Highlands promptly at 1pm to sign in. Then we will meet outside where I will give you invitations for a "wander" in the wild. You may want to wander far on the grounds at Highlands, or you may stay close and even sit on a bench. You can participate in this immersive experience either way. Please keep in mind that with good luck, the entire retreat will be outdoors!


I have led retreats in this way before and they tend to be powerful experiences because we are immersing ourselves in God's creation. Colossians 1:16-17 states about Jesus the Christ, *For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.* I am not sure we really believe that when we go out into God's creation, which the early church called "the first body of Christ" (informed by Colossians 1:16-17), it is held together through Christ, or that Christ can speak to us through the first incarnation. But as a wilderness guide, I know God can speak, and that much healing can take place when we immerse ourselves in nature and listen.

Please know this retreat may stretch you. In fact, I would be disappointed if it didn't. You may also find renewal, peace of mind, and a deeper connection with God's creation. We will wander close by the lodge or wander by the creek, rocks, trees, or pond. Bring a journal and pen, a water bottle, sunscreen, a hat and a rain jacket. I will also lead us to meet "council style" to conclude the retreat, and we will finish promptly at 5pm. There is a \$5 fee for Highlands which the Spiritual Journey's budget will support for each person.


We are looking for volunteers to drive members to doctor appointments, Sunday worship services, or just out for coffee or ice cream. Call Wanda Heibein if you can help.


