#### Westview Presbyterian Church



Dear Westview,

I am pleased to announce a new initiative on Sunday mornings after worship to create a space that is multigenerational but focused and more deeply connected with youth. This initiative is a response to information shared by the congregation at the September town hall meetings, and my direct communication with youth at the church.

The initiative is a different way of gathering than traditional Sunday School. Starting at 10:45 a.m. (which may need to be adjusted to as late as 11:00 a.m. as we move forward) and lasting for 45 to 60 minutes, we will meet "council style" in the youth room.

"Council style" has several spiritual disciplines feathered into the gathering. When we meet in council, we have a talking stick and the only person who has the floor to speak is the one holding the stick. This means no interrupting, no "cross talk" (having a side conversation while someone else is speaking), no giving advice, no rescuing, and no solving another person's problems.

There are four intentions in council. The first is to "**speak from the heart**" where we get to what is stirring within you. This is not a place where we share our opinions on the world. We are not interested in what you think as much as how the Spirit of God is moving in you, forming you to be more like Christ (Ephesians 3:17). The second intention is to "**listen from the heart**" or "listen with the heart" as you receive what is being evoked by the other person speaking. This is not really a discussion group as much as a discerning group. When someone shares something in council, we receive it in silence, not by trying to fix the other person and their problems. The Third intention is to "**let yourself be surprised**" by what you say. When you speak from the heart, your spontaneity may surprise you in curious ways. Finally, the fourth intention is to be "**lean of expression**." As the council carrier, I may ask you to "come to the point" if you ramble on and on. Our "curriculum" will be the devotional guide in the worship bulletin that accompanies the sermon text for the day.

All are welcome to attend this new experiment which will run Sunday October 31<sup>st</sup> through Sunday December 19<sup>th</sup>, when we will pause to evaluate the experience. However, please know this setting will not appeal to everybody. We are going to be attentive to the younger people in the room and offer a place where they can be seen and heard. We will adhere fiercely to the four intentions of council.

One more ministry item of note, **Stewardship Sunday is November 14<sup>th</sup>.** Be on the lookout for more information on the ministry initiatives of the church for 2022, as we continue our emergence from three years between installed pastors and focus on the good and beautiful things that our happening at our church.


The Quiet Room/Nursery, at the back of the sanctuary, has been cleaned out and reorganized. A big thank you to Wanda Heibein for her help.
